The vessel “**LAUNCH ‘M,**” a 2001 34’ Sea Vee with twin 440 H.P. Yanmar diesel inboard engines, was reported stolen from **Sunset Marina** in **Miami Beach**, Florida on or about October 28, 2009. The hull is white with a dark blue bottom and a dark blue stripe at the water line. The vessel’s name, “*Launch ‘M,*” and hailing port “Miami Beach, FL” appears on the stern. “LAUNCH ‘M” also appears on both the port and starboard bow. The vessel has a white interior and full tuna tower. The **USCG Documented** vessel (**1108520**) is registered in Florida. The **HIN** is **SXJ00611B101**. The twin, 440 H.P. Yanmar diesel inboard engines have **Model Numbers: 6LY2A-STP** and **Serial Numbers: M52179 (Port) & M52240 (Starboard)**. The theft was reported to the Miami Beach Police Department under case number 09-122163.
