2005 43' Nor Tech Sport Fish w// Triple 315 HP Yanmar Engines

Actual Vessel (Note: The bow spotlight has been removed & the windless in the photo has been upgraded to a large roller-type windless enclosed in an above deck box.)



The M/V “**TAILCHASER**,” a 2005 43’ Nor Tech with triple 315 H.P. Yanmar diesel inboard engines, was reported stolen from a private dock in Cape Coral, Florida on or about January 20, 2010. The hull and interior of the vessel are white. The t-top is a dark navy blue canvas. The manufacturer’s name, “**Nor Tech**,” appears in dark blue letters on the starboard and port sides of the stern. The name of the vessel was removed from the stern prior to the reported theft; however, there is a visible shadow of where it once was on the stern. Mounted on the bow is a very large drum roller-type windless. The vessel is **USCG Documented** under number **1159038**. The **HIN** is **AOV43016G405**. The theft was reported to the Cape Coral Police Department under case number **10-001255**.
