# 1979 36' Egg Harbor with Twin Detroit Deisels



The vessel "LOT TO SEA," a 1979 36' Egg Harbor Convertible with twin 300 H.P. Detroit Diesel inboard engines, was reported stolen from Fort Lauderdale, Florida on or about June 1, 2010. ***There have been reports of vessel sightings in the Bahamas (Freeport and Nassau).*** The hull is white with black bottom paint. The vessel's name, "LOT TO SEA," appears on the stern. The vessel has a white painted forward deck and a teak wood aft deck. Wide teak rail cap surrounds the vessel and there is teak spray rail on the starboard and port sides. The fly bridge helm station has a beige canvas top covering it. The vessel is **Florida registered** under number **FL 4873 MY**. The **HIN** is **EGG36524M793**. The twin, 300 H.P., 6V-53 Series Detroit Diesels have **Serial Numbers: 6D00179055 (Port) & 6D00178972 (Starboard)**. The theft was reported to the Fort Lauderdale Police Department under case number 10-59021.
