The vessel, "CHARDONNAY," a 1998 42' Sea Ray Sundancer with twin 350 H.P. Caterpillar outboard engines, was reported stolen from Hurricane Cove Marina in Miami, Florida on or about April 24, 2011. The hull is white with black and gold trim. There is a Freedom small boat lift installed on the swim platform. The vessel's name, "CHARDONNAY," appears in gold letters on the stern. The vessel's hailing port, "Palm City, FL," also appears on the stern. The HIN is **SERF6408K798**. The vessel is **U.S. Documented** under number **1191289** and **FL** registered under number **FL 1383 NA**. The twin 350 H.P. Caterpillar engines have **Serial Numbers: 4K607313** (port) and **4K607304** (starboard). The theft was reported to the Miami Police Department under case number 110424-112094.
