

A 2005 33' Blackhawk equipped with twin outboard Yamaha 250 HP engines, was reported stolen from a private residence in Homestead, Florida on or about December 5, 2012. The hull is white below the waterline. Above the waterline custom aqua blue paint extends along the port and starboard sides and gradually darkens at the stern. There are yellow and blue graphics on the port and starboard quarters. A dragon graphic and the name, "OUTTA CONTROL," appear on the vessel's stern. The M/V's HIN is 1T030030H405 and the Registration No. is FL 4325 MS. The twin, 250 HP Yamaha Engines have Serial Numbers: (P) 250 LF TXR 6P3X 1007134J & (S) LF 250 TXR 6P3X 1001564K. At the time of the reported theft, the vessel was atop a triple axel aluminum trailer with HIN: IE9BB34315M322055 and Florida tag # FL ATJV 79. The theft was reported to the Miami-Dade Police Department.
