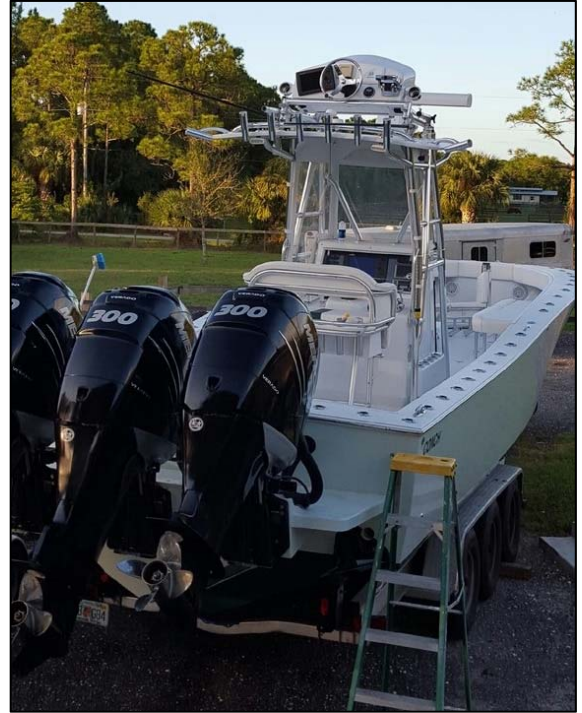

2006 33' Conch with triple 300 HP Mercury Verados

An unnamed **2006 33' Conch** equipped with **triple 2012 300 HP Mercury Verados** engines, was reported stolen from G.T. Marine in Fort Pierce, Florida in the early morning hours of March 12, 2016. The hull is light green with a dark green boot stripe. The interior is white. The vessel has numerous rod holders along the entire gunwale and is equipped with a 2nd Station. The M/V's **HIN** is **OQL00001B506** and Florida Registration No. is **FL 8312 PA**. The triple 300 HP Mercury Verados outboard engines have **Serial Numbers: 18919808 CXL, 18919858 XXL and 18919391 XL**. At the time of theft the vessel was on a new triple axel Float-On trailer (VIN: **404GP3536GF000365, FL Tag No.: 1912 TC**) with six brand new BF Goodrich Commercial tires. The vessel was last seen being towed by a raised white Ford F250. The vessel was reported stolen to the St. Lucie County Sheriff Office, under Case No. 16-02880.
