## "IT'S A WONDERFUL LIFE" 2009 43' Sea Ray With Twin Cummins Zues Engines

"IT'S A WONDERFUL LIFE" A 2009 43' Sea Ray 43DA-D equipped with Twin Cummins Zues Engines was reported stolen from Matheson Hammock Marina in Miami Florida between 9:45 AM and 5:00 PM on May 6, 2017. The vessel's HIN is SERP7555A909. The hull is blue and white and "It's a Wonderful Life" in black, shadowed script appears on the transom along with the hailing port, Coral Gables Florida, in block style lettering. When last seen, the vessel's wrap around solar shades and blue canvas were in place. The Cummins engines model/serial numbers are 425 QSB/46971167 and 46971161. The vessel's Florida Registration number is FL 2822 PS and Decal number is 05675124. The vessel's dinghy, a 2014 9' Achilles HB270FX inflatable, HIN ACH00151K314 with a 6 HP Yamaha engine model/serial number F6SMHA/6BXS 1032203 was mounted on the swim platform at the time of theft. The vessel is equipped with an Intellion Direct TV Satellite and Zues Pod Drive. The theft has been reported to the Miami Dade Police Department under case number PD170508 173958.
